With pleasure I present to you the Annual Report 2014 - 15 of TKMCPS. The year was a blessed one in which we were led through by the grace of God Almighty through thick and thin.

TKMCPS with its strength of 4,200 student, 152 Teaching staff and 91 non-teaching staff has functioned successfully to achieve the mission of TKM Institutions. The school started the Academic Year with the opening of class IX, X and XII on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2014. The result of AISSCE and AISSE 2014 brought good news.

Of the 211 students who appeared for the class XII AISSCE 76 passed out with distinction. Haris. N and Fidha Mariyam stood first in the Science stream with 95.4%, Anand Mahadevan came 2<sup>nd</sup> with 94.6%. Swathi Scored 90% to come first in the Commerce stream. The highest in Maths and Biology was 100%. Malayalam 99%, Chemistry 98%, English 97%, Physics 95%, Computer Science 97%, Engineering Graphics 95%, Accountancy 95%, Business Studies 94% and Economics 70%. Haris. N was the recipient of the 'SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGHER EDUCATION' of the Government of India. Monisha, Anand Mahadevan, Fidha Mariyam, Ayisha Kahar, Ananthakrishnan UK and Sareena A Salam received letter of appreciation from Mrs. SmrithyIrani, the Human Resource Development Minister of the Government of India for their outstanding performance in the class XII AISSCE.

Of the 238 students who appeared for the class X AISSE 2014 forty got full A1 and 121 got CGPA 9 and above.

The school cabinet of 40 members was sworn in by the Chairman Jb. Shahal Hassan Musaliar and Sohail Khan, Hyru Sulthana and Thalha Thaha of class XI took charge as the Head Boy, Head Girl and Sports Captain respectively.

**In the OISCA Top Teen Contest Ann Rachel Panicker of class VIII came first amongst girls in Kollam. In the Venad Sahodaya Inter School Athletic Meet Salman Thaha of class X won the Gold Medal 1500 mts. and Abdulla MR of class X Gold Medal in 200 mts.**

**In the VenadSahodaya Roller Skating Competition Sruthi N of class X came first in Rink II and A. She was the winner in the State and National Junior Roll Ball Championship too. Shameema of class VII was the winner in Sree Chithira Tennis Tournament and in the Trivandum Open Tennis Tournament.**

**Our School Team was third in the Venad Sahodaya Inter School Football Tournament.**

### **Student enrichment programmes**

Regular Counseling and expert guidance help students in their personality development. English speaking is promoted through the communicative English classes of the Institute of Language Management, Bangalore. Interactive classes are supported by NIIT. Experiential learning is systematically encouraged by the B Box. Entrance Oriented Special classes are conducted by TKM School of communication. Football coaching by the football association of Kerala motivates the young Footballers of TKMCPS.

Gardening, Yoga, Art, Music, Physical Education are co-curricular activities that the students engage in. The four houses Ruby, Emerald, Diamond and Opal vie with each other for the cultural arts and sports competition. The Diamond House came out as champions this year. The activities of 9 clubs namely Language Club, Maths Club, Science Club, Social Science Club, Eco Club, Heritage Club, Integrity Club, Computer Science Club and Health and Wellness Club provide opportunities to learn from experience.

### **Social Responsibilities**

**Our students collected Rs. 3, 89,750 for charity this year and disbursed Rs. 41680 to the Prime Ministers Relief Fund, Rs. 15000 each to two cancer patients, Rs. 25000 to a kidney patient, Rs. 10,000 to specially challenged girl child and Rs. 2, 00,000 is set aside to meet the medical expenditure of one of our students suffering from an inborn defect. The contribution from the students, the proceeds from the sale of greeting cards and sale proceeds of the vegetables from the school garden were put together to make the charity fund.**

### **Infrastructure**

**Our infrastructure is exemplary. We have a state of the art library of 3280 sq.ft. with nearly 25000 books, 41 periodicals and 6 dailies which is something that we are truly proud of. The new Mathematics Lab was inaugurated on 5<sup>th</sup> November by our Hon'ble Chairman Jb. Shahal Hassan Musaliar and maintained by the NIIT. The spacious school ground gives the students ample space to sweat out their redundant energy. The Computer Lab equipped with modern gadgets can accommodate 300 students at a time. We are blessed to**

have spacious airy class rooms, modernized auditorium to seat 1200, interactive classes, full time counselor and a first aid room with a qualified nurse.

### **Staff**

The management has given adequate incentives and resources for capacity building for individuals to grow and educational services to be delivered. Orientation programmes are regular affairs in TKMCPS. Workshop on life skill and value education by Mr. Ramakrishnan, ICR Training by Abid of NIIT, Teachers role as relationship manager by Mr. Rajeevan, Teacher responsibilities by Mr. Ranjith, on being the best teacher by Dr. Mridula, Teacher as a counselor by Dr. Arun, Psycho Osmosis by Dr. Madhujan, Personality development and time management by Mr. Nazeem were a few general classes. Subject wise workshops are conducted diligently.

We have a staff club which is very active with Mrs. Sreekala RC as the staff secretary supported by an executive council of 9 members. The Staff Tour and the gatherings hold us colleagues together.

The work of the whole school brought recognition from the Confederation of Kerala Sahodayas with the best school award received at Devagiri CMI Public School, Calicut.
