of Trust the immovable property mentioned above and described particularly in the Schedule here to and all his contributions, collections and constructions made in the property and extinguishes all his rights these on his favour of the persons mentioned above on the terms given under. - 3 - Thengal kurju musaliar (sd) - 3 - definitions 'Founder' means Tanab S. Thengal kurju musaliar 'College' means Thengal kurju musaliar college, or such other institution attached to or forming part of the same or under the management of the Trust. 'Trustees' means the persons mentioned above in whose favour this Deed is declared. 'Board' means the Trust Board constituted ~~with~~ with the trustee mentioned above and the members co-opted under the Constitution of Board as provided, here under: Constitution of the Trust Board: the Founder hereby affirms that the trustee mentioned above together with the members co-opted to the Board as here in after provided shall constitute the Trust Board. The Founder shall be a member of the Trust Board for his life time and he shall be the ~~President~~ President of the Trust Board after

his life time, the trustee shall elect a president for the Board from among themselves. The number of members of the Board shall be not less than nine, and not more than fifteen including the four members co-opted in the following manner: 1. One member to be nominated by the university of Travancore 2. One member to be nominated from among the members of the WAKF Board of the state by the chairman of the WAKF Board. 3. One member to be elected by those charitable individuals who contribute a minimum of Rupees Ten thousand each from among themselves, provided there are not less than ten individuals so qualified. 4. One member to be the principal of the proposed college to be appointed by the Trustees. The founder shall be entitled to nominate other members to the Trust Board, but so as not to exceed the maximum of fifteen as provided *supra*: — A. Thargal kunjū Musaliar (sd) — 4 —

Term of office of the members: The members nominated by the university, and WAKF Board as also the principal of the college shall hold office by virtue of their respective positions and shall retire from the Board on termination of their respective qualifying positions. The members —

elected by the qualifying contributions shall hold office for a period of three years limit. He is eligible for re-election. The trustees shall hold office of membership in the Board for their lifetime. Vacancies caused by death or otherwise shall be filled by nomination by the Founder and after his lifetime by co-option by surviving trustees. The members so long as their number is not less than nine including the president shall be competent to transact all and every business of the Board, notwithstanding any vacancy or or vacancies on the Board not having been filled in objects of the Trust. The objects of this Trust are to establish, run, maintain, carry on, furnish, improve and enlarge Thangal Kunju Musaliar College and if thought fit or necessary, start or take over other educational institutions, and for the said purpose to collect funds, levy fees, acquire lands, erect buildings and hostels, equip laboratories, provide sports facilities for students and staff of the College and other institutions taken over or started by the Board, grant scholarships to students, encourage and provide for research work





And do all acts and things necessary in that behalf properties Vested in the Trust Board. The Trustees shall hold all the properties transferred to them by this deed including those specified in the schedule here to any other properties and funds which may here after be endowed to or acquired by them for the use and purposes of Thangal Kurju Musalia College of any other institutions started or taken over as provided supra — Thangal Kurju Musalia (9d) - 5 —

The Trustees shall, from and out of the income realised from the funds and resources of the College, and from other sources of income such as endowments, donations, subscriptions, contributions and grants-in-aid which the College may get. Expend such sum or sums of money, as the Board may deem fit and proper towards the maintenance of the college and other institutions in regular and suitable conditions, pay all rates and other dues which may become <sup>due</sup> ~~due~~ and meet all <sup>expenses</sup> ~~impulses~~ which the Board may in their direction think necessary for the proper and efficient management of the institutions, in particular, pay salaries wages and

allowances of staff and servants, purchase books, equipment and furniture, award prizes and scholarships to students and to incur any other items of expenditure relating to the institutions under management of the Board not here in before specifically mentioned it being understood that the remuneration is not ~~executives~~ <sup>is subject to</sup> powers and ~~interest~~ of the Board and Trustees. The Board shall be in complete management of the affairs of the College and other institution under this Trust. Without prejudice to the above said general powers of the Trustees shall have powers to purchase or take on lease lands, buildings, equipment, materials and things, to erect and maintain buildings and other constructions, and to sell, mortgage or dispose of or otherwise deal with or any of the same as they may think fit and proper with best interests of the Trust to levy such fees from the students and deal with the proceeds as they may think proper to grant loans or borrow moneys as they may think fit and proper consistent with the management of the Trust. 

